[burning of fossil fuels understanding global change](#) Feb 18 2022 fossil fuels form over millions of years from the burial of photosynthetic organisms including plants on land which primarily form coal and plankton in the oceans which primarily form oil and natural gas to grow these organisms removed carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and the ocean and their burial inhibited the movement of that carbon through the carbon cycle
